### **FTC to Host Virtual Meeting with Stakeholders in the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) Industry in Trinidad and Tobago**

The Fair Trading Commission (“the Commission”) as part of its ongoing sensitisation efforts to increase awareness of the benefits of competition and ultimately to promote and maintain fair and effective competition throughout the local economy will be hosting a virtual meeting with the overall theme of “*Competition Policy and MSMEs*” on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2022.
